About PPMA

Pacific Pearl Music Association (PPMA) was established in 2007, and it became a non-profit organization in 2009. PPMA's mission is to enrich the lives of its members as well as those of the communities (Conejo Valley of Southern California) through music and dancing performances, and to introduce Chinese culture to other ethnic groups in the community.

PPMA has three affiliated sub-groups: Yangsheng Choir (YSC), Thousand Oaks Chinese Folk Ensemble (TOCFE), and Thousand Oaks Dance Ensemble (TODE). The members of these three groups come from all walks of life with very diversified personal and professional background; but they all share same passion in performing arts and serving their communities.

Since inception, PPMA has grown significantly in its membership and has made big impact on the local communities. Besides actively participating in local events, members have travelled to Santa Barbara, Santa Paula and the Greater Los Angeles areas to perform on stages large and small.



Our members come from all sorts of different professions and backgrounds. Each sub-group practices at least twice a month and serves the community throughout the year.

Yangsheng Choir (YSC)

YSC has been dedicated to expressing our love for Chinese culture by singing songs, transmitting the long history of Chinese culture, and actively participating in various events.

Thousand Oaks Chinese Folk Ensemble (TOCFE)

TOCFE now has a percussion team, an Erhu team, and a strong pluck string team including Pipa, dulcimer, Guzheng / Chinese zither.

Thousand Oaks Dance Ensemble (TODE)

TODE, PPMA's newest and now largest subgroup, has three dance teams: folk dance, ballroom dance and fitness dance.
